Call for Scholarship Applications for Year 8 students commencing secondary education in 2026

Eligible to Year 8 students who plan to attend:

- > Taranaki / Whanganui based Secondary Schools in 2026 or
- > Wellington based Catholic Secondary Schools in 2026.

Day School and Boarding Scholarships are available.

Preference is given to students from less well-off backgrounds who would otherwise have difficulty paying their school fees and meeting other school costs.

Applications for any field of study will be considered but further preference will be given to those students planning a career in agriculture related fields.
